What can Parents do?

You are the most influential person and role model in your child's life. You most likely will be faced with the challenge of addressing your child's exposure to drugs or violence. Providing guidance to teens is not a democracy. In fact, over two-thirds of teenagers see great risk of upsetting their parents or losing their respect if they were to use drugs. Parents need to purposely help their teen steer clear of drug use and antisocial behavior.

• **Monitor your teen's unsupervised time!** Know where they are, who they are with and what they are doing. A good rule of thumb is **"trust but verify!"**

• **Become involved in your teen's school success!** Parents should have monthly contact with teachers and support your teen's academic success. Contact via phone, email and attendance at parent-teacher conferences are ways to stay involved. **Expect to see homework and praise your child for high quality schoolwork!**

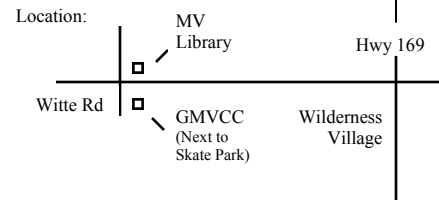
